Old Business:

#705 ~ Homeowner was questioning what the status of the generator was. He offered to help us sell the generator Dennis said he will ask Grant to start the process of selling the generator for \$16,500. 11/12/2024 ~ Homeowner has placed the ad on craigslist with Dennis's phone number. 12/23/24 ~ Dennis had a request to purchase the generator. This was refused because it was a low-ball offer. Dennis is waiting to hear back. 1/14/2025 ~ Dennis is still waiting. 2/11/2025 ~ David will follow up with the 705. 5/13/2024 ~ Dave and the homeowner updated the posting.

#672 ~ was questioning his water usage. His December usage was over 20,000 gallons. Brian did check the meter 12-13 days ago with the wife. Brian verified that the when the water was shut off there was no meter reading. The board reviewed his annual billing and Brian suggested changing his meter tomorrow. 2/25/2025~ Brian changed the meter. 3/11/25 ~ meter has been changed. We are monitoring usage. 5/13/2025 ~ the board reviewed the usage before and after the meter change. It is the decision of the board that the water went thru the meter and that amount is owed. Letter will be mailed. Closed

The homeowner at #525 has been out of town for the last 2-3 months. He had extremely high-water usage while they were gone. Mercy suggested that we install a new meter and follow it for the next 60 days to see what is going on. They will be gone off and on over the next few months. 3/25/2025 ~ New meter was installed. We will observe the usage for the next 60 days, but the outstanding flat rate needs to be paid. 5/13/2025 ~ Kristie talked to the homeowner and reviewed the usage. The usage prior to meter change is drastically higher than the usage after the change. Kristie proposed that the homeowner will pay the monthly fees and to charge the usage for 2024 (the previous year) plus 20%. Arny will determine how to properly adjust this and report at the next meeting.

3/25/2025~ Dennis and Jerry have gone down the Credit Union to get Mercy added. 4/8/2025 ~ Kristie has been at the credit union. 5/13/25~ Still waiting for Dave and Mercy.

New Business:

DEQ sent us letter and we are on a reduced monitoring on Lead and Copper from semi annually to annually.

Dave suggested that get a Debit/Credit card. He had to use his personal card to pay the domain name bill.

Dave also mentioned that we need have someone responsible for reading the emails. Mercy will make a point of checking the email twice a month. Arny also checks the email.

Christy supplied the board with the 2024 CCR Consumer Confidence Report. We have 25 violations reported in there because we missed a testing cycle by 22 days. We did test and all results were negative, but end result is we missed the test cycle by 22 days. Brian and Royce will review the testing schedule.
